

## Description

The seat is made of 38 x 160 mm slats in exotic hardwood (without stain).

The legs of the high table are in painted cast iron.

A steel cross bar links the legs to the slats.

All parts are assembled with stainless steel screws.


The legs include special stainless steel M20 anchor rods and a finishing cap to hide the anchorage holes.



The seat is made of 38 x 90 mm slats in exotic hardwood (without stain).

The legs of the seat are in painted cast iron. Depending on the version, the backrest bars are in steel.

Seating parts are fastened together by steel plates.

All parts are assembled with stainless steel screws.

The legs include special stainless steel M20 anchor rods and a finishing cap to hide the anchorage holes.





The legs include special stainless steel M20 anchor rods and a finishing cap to hide the anchorage holes.




