▶ Presentation

The Campus 4 litter bin is part of the modern range of steel bins. The originality of this piece of street furniture lies in the combination of painted steel and aluminium.

This furniture has been designed and manufactured by Sineu Graff, experts in urban landscaping, in accordance with a sustainable development approach.

Description

The bin is made up of 5mm thick cast aluminium slats, 3mm thick upper and lower inner rails, an intermediate ring in 1.5mm thick painted galvanized steel, a 4mm thick painted galvanized steel base, a 6mm thick cast aluminium lid and a galvanized steel bucket.

Steel parts are zinc plated, then they undergo our powder blast process (after cleaning and shot blasting, they are coated with a first coat of epoxy powder, and then with a second coat of polyester powder).

The slats are fixed to the inner rails with screws.

The lower rail is fastened to the base with screws and nuts.

The intermediate ring is assembled on the base using screws.

The bin lid is fitted on a hinge.

Closing is automatic, while opening is done via a triangular key.


